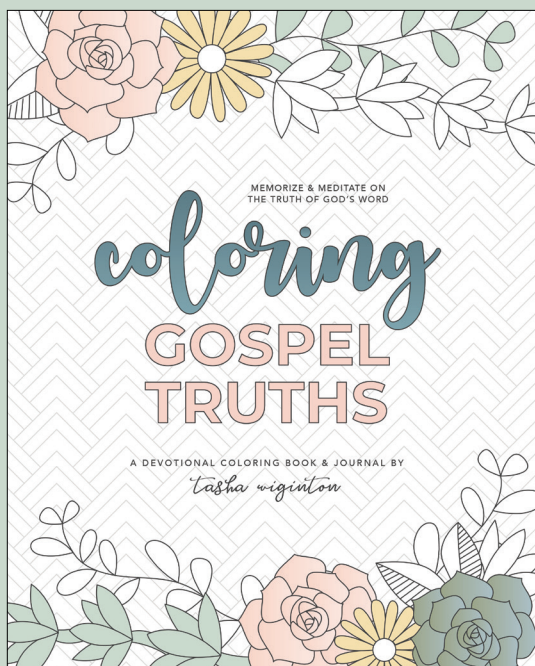


COLORING GOSPEL TRUTHS
